The NAMTA Foundation Educational Scholarship fund is governed and administered by the NAMTA Foundation, Inc.

NAMTA Foundation Educational Scholarship applicant:

- **Must be an employee, or family member of an employee**, of a NAMTA member firm in good standing. A family member is defined as a father, mother, stepparent, son, daughter, stepson, stepdaughter, brother, sister, stepbrother, or stepsister.
- Must be studying or planning to study at an accredited university, college or technical school. **(The NAMTA Foundation Educational Scholarship does NOT require the applicant to major in art related fields.)**
- Must graduate from high school or its equivalent before July 1 of the year in which they will receive the scholarship, if awarded.
- Will be judged on grade point average, extracurricular activities and financial need.

Only the formal application will be accepted, though attachments to the form are acceptable. A high school or equivalent transcript must be submitted showing grade point average for the most recently completed year or course. Extracurricular activities may be included on the transcript, but must also be listed on the formal application form.

Letters of recommendation or endorsements will be accepted but are not required.

Scholarship funds, if awarded, are for future use, not payment of past expenses or credit balances on accounts, and will be distributed directly to the institution the student will study.

The name and contact information of the NAMTA member firm where the applicant or family member is employed must be shown.

The name and contact information of the institution where the recipient will be studying must be shown.

Applications must be received with a transcript showing grade point average for the most recently completed year or course, or the application will be considered incomplete and not considered.

Fill out pages 2 and 3 of this application. Question 18 requires a separate page for your essay.
